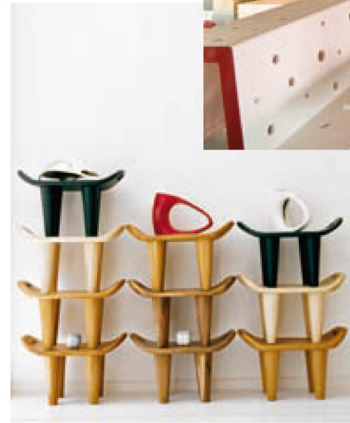
## Get ready. Design. Go
